Metformin 500mg	Two tablets three times a day		
Gliclazide 60mg MR	One tablet twice daily		
Pravastatin 20mg	One tablet daily		
Thyroxine 50microgram	One tablet daily		
Amlodipine 5mg	One tablet daily		
Indapamide 2.5mg	One tablet daily		
Temazepam 10mg	Take one tablet prn for sleep		
Mylanta DS liquid	20ml prn
